Governor Edward G. Rendell signed the new Right-To-Know law on February 14, 2008 fundamentally changing the way people access public records of their government. A "photocopy" is either a single-sided copy or one side of a double-sided black and white copy of a standard 8.5' x 11" page	\$0.25 a page
Certification of a Record	\$1 per record
Specialized documents(For example, blue prints,color prints, non-standard size documents)	actual cost for postage
<p>Prepayment: Prior to granting a request for access in accordance with this Act, an agency may require a requester to prepay an estimate of the fees authorized under this section if the fees required to fulfill the request are expected to exceed \$100.</p> <p>Once the request is fulfilled and prepared for release, the fees must be collected before the release of the records.</p>
